*Applicable only to students joining internships. ** Practicals will be assessed continuously and at the end of each semester evaluation of Practicals will be done by two examiners. (From Clause 17, Ordinance 14)

Note:

- Vacations shall be as per the University orders.
- Cultural and sports activities shall be organized strictly in accordance with the schedule notified for University Teaching Departments (UTDs) from time to time.
- The first test shall normally cover Unit-I & Unit-II and the second test shall normally cover Unit-III & Unit-IV of the syllabus and the third test shall cover Unit-V of the syllabus. Students falling short of the prescribed attendance shall not be permitted to appear in tests and examinations.
- All schedules are announced regularly by the Administrative Office and may be revised due to unavoidable circumstances.
- Students must check the website/notice boards regularly and **must ensure at least 75% attendance**.
- The syllabus shall be completed by arranging extra classes, if required.
- For PG Courses – MTech & MSc II Year (III and IV Semester) where only the dissertation phase exists, there shall be three internal presentations in each semester in lieu of tests as per the above-mentioned schedule.
- For all academic matters pertaining to attendance, examination scheme, curriculum etc. Ordinance 14 (CBCS) will be strictly followed.
- The **approved curriculum**, including **Programme Outcomes (POs), Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs), Programme Educational Objectives (PEOs), Course Outcomes (COs)**, along with the **Examination Scheme and Time Table**, shall be uploaded on the IET website **prior to the commencement of each semester**.
- The list of students having **shortage of attendance** shall be displayed **at the end of every month** for information and necessary action.
- In case of unavoidable circumstances, the **internal committee** of the concerned department may make **minor revisions** in the internal test schedule, subject to **prior approval of the competent authority**.
- Departments having a partial dissertation phase in IV Semester, may arrange a pre-presentation of the dissertation, which shall be considered equivalent to the third test.
- Regular teaching classes shall not ordinarily be conducted on Saturdays. However, Saturdays may be utilized for class tests, practical examinations, remedial classes, expert lectures, or compensatory academic activities with approval of the competent authority.
